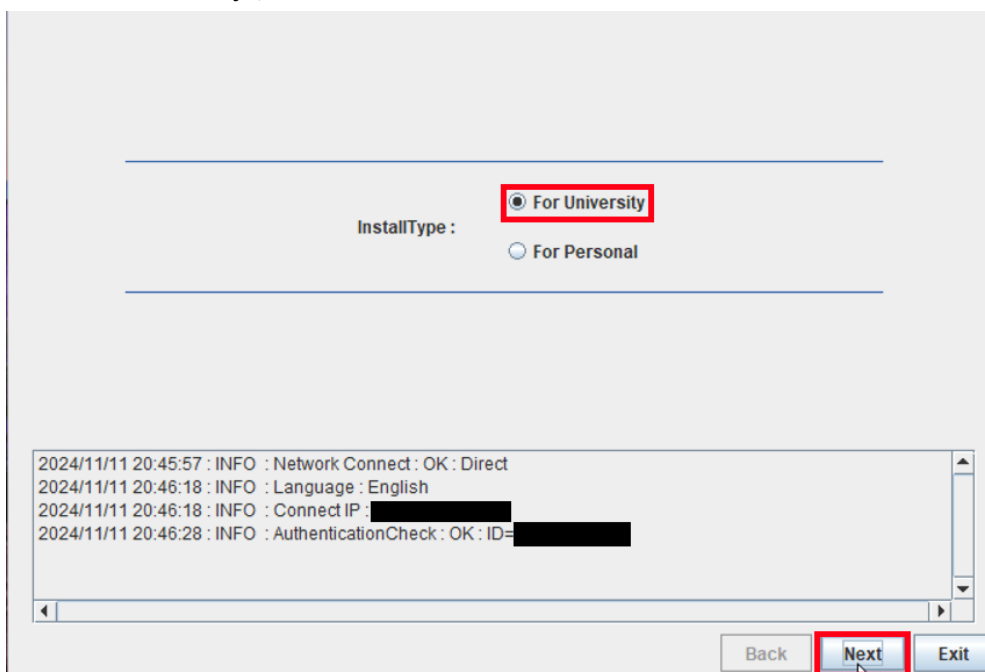

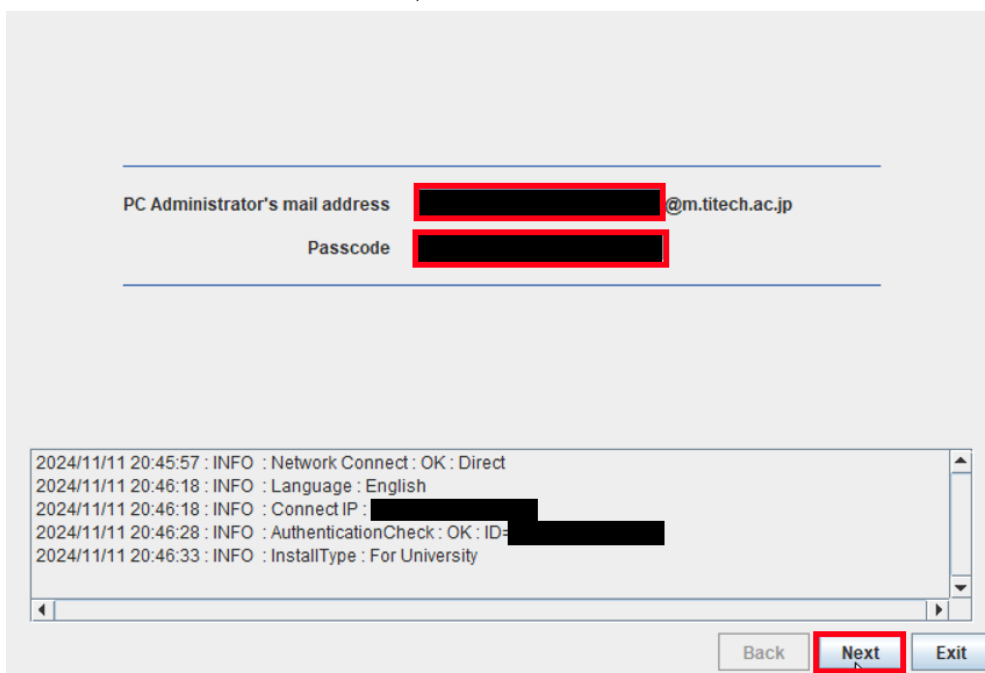

Check [For University], and click [Next].

Type the mail address of The Tokyo Tech Mail System of PC Administrator who was decided at “2 Decide who to be PC Administrator” and the Passcode¹ which was obtained at “3 Obtain a Passcode”, and click [Next].



¹ If the Passcode which was obtained at “3 Obtain a Passcode” is invalid, follow the operation “3 Obtain a Passcode” again and type it.

Check the row which fulfills following conditions, and click [Next].

- The OSName column of the row is “Windows”.
- The Explain column of the row contains “Shared Device License”.

Notes on the Installing Software (Adobe Creative Cloud : Shared Device License : Windows OS : 64bit / x64)

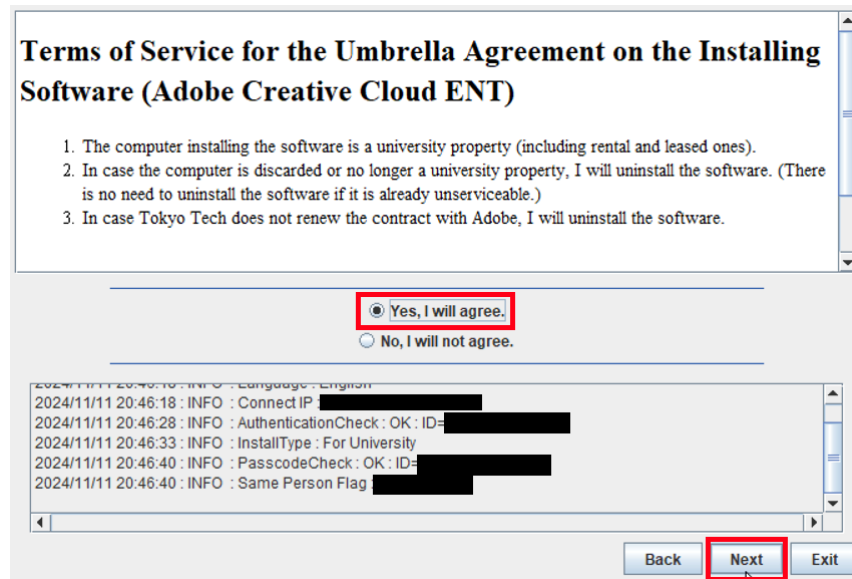
1. This is a license for university-owned PC which is supposed to be used on campus.
2. You are able to use this Adobe products on 64 bit OS only. However, Windows 7 and Windows 8.1 are not supported.
3. After installing, please start "Adobe Creative Cloud".
4. You are able to select and install each application from "Adobe Creative Cloud".
5. You are necessary to log in with Adobe ID.
6. As countermeasures against unauthorized use, it is possible to start applications on campus network only. When you strongly need to use applications temporarily on outside campus network, please use them via SSL-VPN.
7. When multiple users use Adobe products on the same device, make sure not to forget to log out Adobe

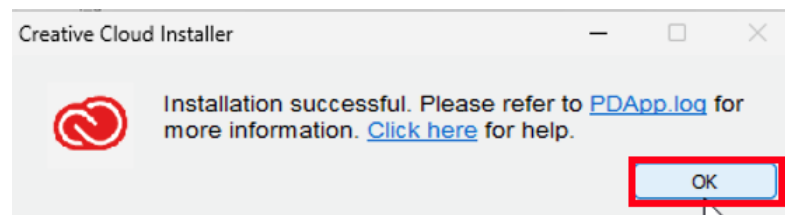

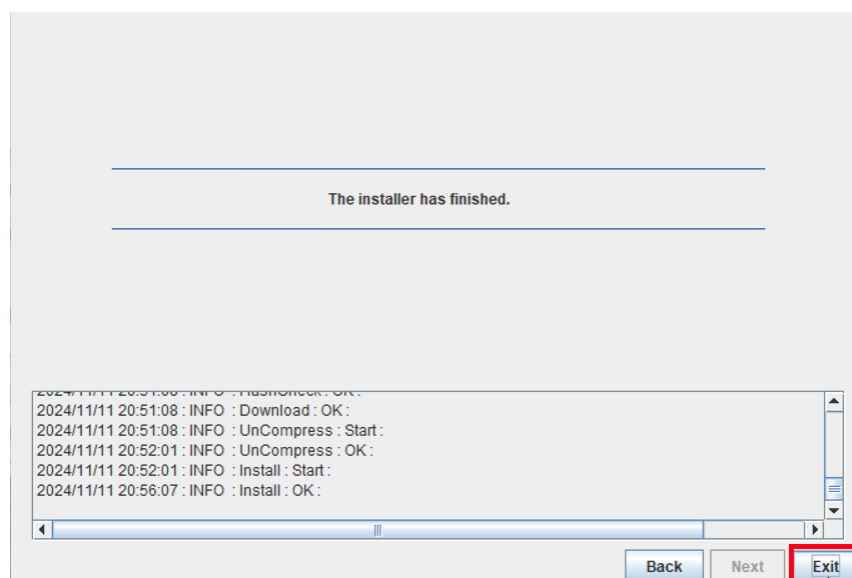

Launch the Creative Cloud desktop app as follows.⁴

- Windows: Do any of the following:
 - Double-click the Adobe Creative Cloud icon on the desktop.
 - Click Start button > Adobe Creative Cloud.
 - Click the Creative Cloud icon on the taskbar.

If you use TokyoTech Adobe AuthID, enter your TokyoTech Adobe AuthID* and click [Continue]. If you're redirected to Tokyo Tech Portal, Log in. If you receive the message: The information above would be shared with the service if you proceed. Do you agree to abide by information security rules of Tokyo Tech and proceed to the next step?, click [同意して次に進む / agree and proceed].

² It is not necessary to be done “6”-“8” by the person who have done the steps other than “6”-“8”. For example the person who did not do “5 Install Creative Cloud desktop App” can do “6”-“8”.

³ It is possible to personally obtain and use an Adobe ID that is not a TokyoTech Adobe Auth ID (not recommended).

* Note: In the future, personally obtained Adobe IDs may prevent products with a comprehensive license from being used.

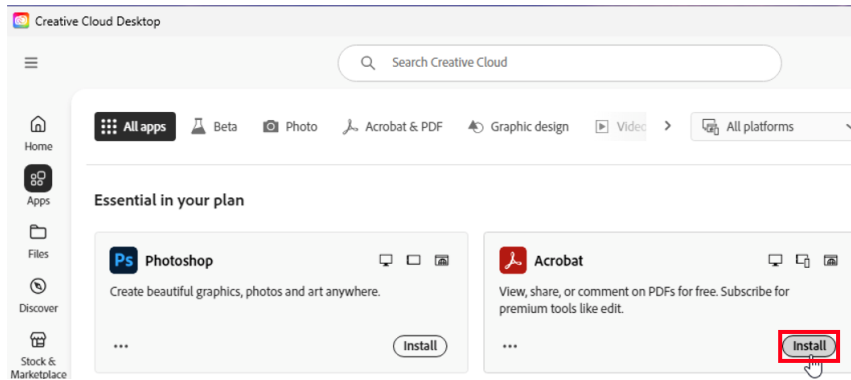

If you receive the message: *Welcome to Adobe Creative Cloud* , click [Done].



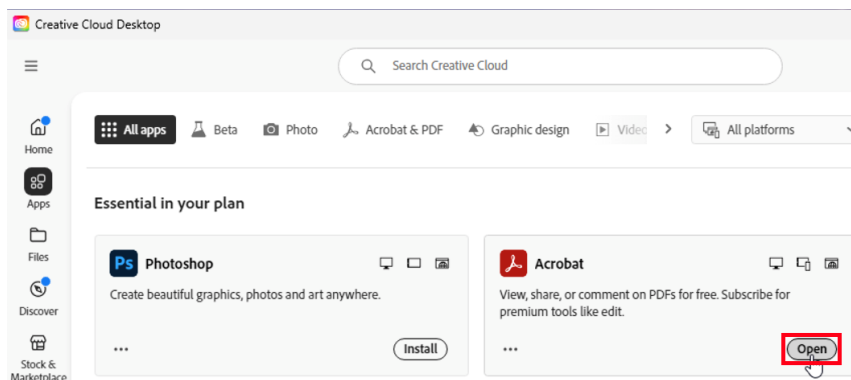
